This is a worldwide ministry that focuses on teaching the heart of our heavenly Father whose love is wider, deeper and higher than we can imagine. If we are touched by our Father's love, we can love others more.

It's less than 2 months that we will go on furlough. Thank you for serving our great Father with us through your support in different ways. We are forever grateful to God who calls us to serve the Khmer people, and also to all of you who support and remember us faithfully throughout these years.
