- Joe's hernia operation was on December 6. He is in recovery.
- Alpha Course is going well with the staff of Sonlight Kindergarten. They are open to discussion and receptive to the message.

Prayers:

- In order to register for the 2-year registration of our Livingston Stone Church we need to have at least 50 members with their names and ID numbers, organizational chart, constitution and foreign support.
- Our Sonlight Kindergarten was reopened in November, but after a week the education department required students aged 3-4 old to get covid vaccinations (children aged 5 years and above were vaccinated). Please pray that our Kindergarten can reopen again soon!
- Rambo, the teacher of our kindergarten, has been coming to our church regularly. He used to study at a Bible School, but because of the bad example of the leaders he was backsliding. Please pray that he has the passion to read God's word and pray.
- Since the reopening of the in person worship the children Sunday School has been resumed in early November. Pray for more teachers.
- Liza's blood pressure is in the border line. The doctor suspects that either it is hereditary or taking too much salt.
