Many things are happening that are alarming to the world: new variants of Covid 19, the strong earthquakes in Haiti that killed thousands of people, the recent unrest in Afghanistan, wildfires in the west of USA and Canada, the floods in China and Europe.

The number of Covid 19 cases in Cambodia has been coming down in August because of the curfew in Phnom Penh and other cities. But the government is concerned that the Delta variant cases will be rising; they recorded 999 cases in 23 provinces as of August 22.

However, as Christians we do not need to be afraid because of the promise of God in Psalm 29:10 "The Lord sat enthroned at the Flood, and the Lord sits as King forever." Our God is still in control in the chaos of the world! All we need to do is to keep watch and pray!
